We began charter services in May 2017 using Aero Contractor Company Ltd (Aero contractor) Eurocopter AS365N3 S/N; 6709 (BHX) Aircraft, on a wet lease basis to service offshore helicopter charter contract for an indigenous oil producing company for a period.

The vision of the founder, Mr. Emmanuel Olufemi Asiyanbi is to provide commercial

aviation services to High Net worth organization, corporate organization needing Air Cargo and other related logistics charter services.

We operate throughout Nigeria and West Africa, offering high-quality services to corporate clients in need of logistics and charter solutions. We maintain technical agreements with aircraft lessors in Europe and the USA for reliable dry/wet lease arrangements.

We operate wet/dry-leased ATR 72-500F aircraft with an 8-ton capacity, featuring unique bulk configuration and compatibility with industry-standard unit load devices for optimized loading and interlining with larger freighters.

MARKET OPPORTUNITY

Nigeria's aviation sector is set for strong growth in 2025 and beyond, driven by policy reforms, infrastructure upgrades, and AfCFTA regional integration—especially in **air cargo and helicopter charters**.

The **air cargo market**, valued at **USD 8.18 billion**, is expanding on the back of e-commerce (USD 6.7 billion in 2023), new intra-African routes, and rising non-oil exports like perishables and pharmaceuticals, forecast to grow **11.2% CAGR** through 2030. Domestic freight is growing **9.8% CAGR**, supported by improved regional airports, cold-chain logistics, and projects like Ogidigben Gas Park driving time-critical charter demand.

Helicopter charters, worth **USD 43 million** in 2025 with **7.5% annual growth**, are buoyed by offshore oil operations, VIP transport, tourism, and medevac services. Operators are expanding fleets, with opportunities in corporate demand and fractional ownership despite regulatory levies.

Additional openings in **MRO, leasing, and airport concessions** are attracting private capital, reinforcing Nigeria's emergence as a **West African aviation hub**.


We consolidate cargoes from multiple shippers for efficient transportation and partner with giants like DHL and FedEx for bulk-breaking beyond their networks.
